**Week of 7/15/18**

**“Josiah – The Leader of a U-Turn”**

- (1) 2 Kings 22:1-23:25
- (2) Read 2 Kings 22:1-2. What does it mean to “do right in the eyes of the Lord?” How challenging is that?
- (3) Read 2 Kings 22:11-23:3. Discuss the significance of the re-discovery of the Scriptures. What did it trigger in Josiah’s mind?
- (4) Share with the group how the reading/study of Scripture has had on you. Has there been a time when it revealed something that needed to change in your life? Discuss if you are comfortable with doing so.
- (5) Read Hebrews 4:12-13. What are these verses saying? Do you think that it pierced Josiah’s heart? Discuss
- (6) Read 2 Peter 3:18. What does it mean to grow in the grace and knowledge of Christ? How have you grown? What has been most effective in contributing to your growth?
- (7) Read 2 Kings 23:4-20 and make note of the number of idols removed/destroyed. How could so many idols have been present among the people? How easy is it for idols to make their way into our lives?
- (8) What idols do you think are most prevalent in our culture today?
- (9) In the sermon, we were challenged to make our homes, workplaces, playing fields, social media, etc. our mission field. How can you practically do so in your situation?
- (10) Read Exodus 20:2-3. Discuss why we should put God first/not having any gods before Him. What has he done for us?
- (11) Share with the group how they can specifically pray for you at this point in your spiritual journey.
