# AS IT IS IN HEAVEN

## “Kingdom Come”

- (1) How do you define kingdom? What images come to your mind when you hear the word kingdom?
- (2) In the sermon, the point was made that everyone has a kingdom, where your will is done – where what you want to have happen is what does happen. What are your thoughts on this point? How does this affect what you feel your will should be?
- (3) Describe what comes to your mind when you think about/hear the term “Kingdom of God”? What do you picture the Kingdom of God (Heaven) being like?
- (4) Read Mark 1:14-15, Luke 17:20-21, and Matthew 4:17. What is the point that Jesus is making in these statements?
- (5) Have you ever thought about the fact that the Kingdom of God is present now? Does this challenge in any way what you have thought about the Kingdom before now?
- (6) If “kingdom” is where a person’s will is done, what does this mean regarding the Kingdom of God? Share some examples of what it looks like for God’s will to be done now. Have you ever experienced a tension between God’s will and your will? What do you think creates this tension? Explain.
- (7) Give some examples of how Christ demonstrated God’s will while here on earth? What characteristics of heaven were demonstrated in His encounters with others?
- (8) Read John 18:36. What point is Jesus making to Pilate in this response?
- (9) Read Romans 14:17. Have you seen this lived out through someone that you know? Share an example.
