“It’s Our Move!”

- (1) As a review of last week, describe once again the Kingdom values that the early church exhibited. Did you see or hear of any Kingdom values being lived out this past week?
- (2) Read Acts 2:42-47 and Acts 4:32-36. What one or two things do find significant in these passages?
- (3) Discuss what the believers (church) were able to accomplish, with God’s help, because of their unity and partnership with one another. Share examples of how you have witnessed people here at SPBC partnering together in ministry.
- (4) What are some ways that we could partner with others (other churches, businesses, organizations, etc.) outside of our church walls? What might be some potential obstacles to this happening?
- (5) A point was made in the sermon that being Kingdom-focused changes how we keep score as a church. Not that it is a competition, but what is usually measured in regard to church effectiveness? How might it be different if it were more Kingdom-focused?
- (6) Read John 1:27 and 1 John 3:16-18. What “evidence” of our faith do these verses bring out as important? What, if anything, in these do you find the most challenging? Why do you think this is so?
- (7) Read Hebrew 10:24-25 and Hebrews 12:28-29. What are some factors that should impact our worship? Do you find that these are consistently the basis for our worship?
- (8) If someone were to ask you why you believe that it’s important to gather for Sunday worship, how would you respond? What do you find beneficial in your time of corporate worship?
- (9) In thinking back upon our sermons about the Kingdom of God over the last several weeks, what most stands out for you? Have they changed your perspective on what we are called to do as followers of Christ? If so, how?
